The Township Parks and Recreation Board held its regular monthly meeting at the Conewago Township Municipal Building at 7pm on Tuesday March 17, 2009.

Approval of Minutes

The minutes of the February meeting were approved as submitted.

Public Comment

Randy Wright presented a land development plan for the Ralph and Helena Luttrell property located near Laurel Woods. This is a proposed development that is to include ten new lots and also involves moving two existing homes to a different location. The proposed development has been reviewed by the Planning Commission with a second review scheduled in two weeks. Due to the steep contour of the property, Randy Wright recommended the Board accept fee in lieu of instead of dedicated parkland. A motion was made by Ryan Little and seconded by Laurie Rochat to accept the fee in lieu of arrangement. The motion was unanimously approved by the Board.

Board Action and Discussion

Dan Tredinnick reported that he was in attendance at the last Township Supervisors meeting to discuss the issue of Camp Conewago. The Supervisors have agreed to undertake this initiative. A statement of work has been developed by the Township Manager with input by the Chairman of the Parks and Rec board. The Township Manager is currently soliciting candidates for the position of Camp Director. An advertisement for this position will be published in the April 26th edition of The Sun. The Camp is scheduled to run Monday through Thursday from 9:00am to 12:00pm during the weeks of July 27th through August 3rd. Dan Tredinnick also indicated that current research recommends a staff counselor to camper ratio of eight to one.

Dan Tredinnick also reported that a second appraisal is underway regarding the Hershey Trust property as well as the development of a topographical plan for the community park located adjacent to the Conewago Elementary School.

Laurie Roachat also reminded the Board that two fee in lieu of monies will expire this summer and questioned the progress of obtaining bids for the concrete pad to be installed at the picnic area for which this money is earmarked. Dan Tredinnick will remind the Township Manager of this issue.

Adjournment

The meeting was adjourned at approximately 7:35pm
